Maier-Machine in use

After a slight delay in delivery, we have finally been able to start using the brand new CNC-lathe, a Maier Type ML 20F. This machine has been designed for making complex turned parts up to an outer diameter of 20mm. At present, we are producing a part for medical technology.

We are sure that this machine could be an interesting partner for complex parts in the areas of hydraulics or pneumatics, as well as in medical technology.

New investments

Apart from the mentioned new Maier machine, we have also made some other investments in your interests – new machines, measuring and testing devices:

In November 2006 we will be receiving a new DECO 2000/13, complete with high pressure pump and high-frequency spindles.

The new high-frequency spindles we added to our existing DECO 2000/13 are in use for milling a torx head for medical technology. In addition, we have a presetting measuring device by Zoller as well as a surface roughness tester by Mitutoyo.

Delivery bottlenecks for raw materials

The acute delivery bottlenecks and even delivery failures of special copper alloys have been a great trial for us and our customers. The strikes and continuing industrial disputes at Swissmetal Boillat as well as the catastrophic information policies towards customers have been totally unacceptable and incomprehensible for us.

We have practically run out of possibilities for alternative delivery sources. Unfortunately, there are some special goods that until now, no other producer makes.

In addition, the raw material prices, particularly for copper alloys, have increased massively and the improved economic climate has also pushed delivery dates back considerably.

NEW MANPOWER!

After a long search, we have finally been able to find additional support for our production team. From August and September our production team will welcome two new members of staff, whom we already give a big welcome!



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
